- W110 Pecorino, Terre Di Chieti, Poggio Anima**
Light golden colour with notes of quince, pear, lemon zest and dried herbs. 12.5% abv 2021 £26
- W111 Pinot Grigio, Graves del Friuli, San Simone**
Bright and chic, with good acidity and a crisp light feel. Well balanced citrus and pear with a pale straw colour. 12.5 % abv 2020 £34

Germany

- W112 Riesling, Fritz Haag, Mosel**
Produced from traditional slate slopes and handpicked, this estate has been making Riesling since 1605. Well structured, aromatic with peach notes. 11% abv 2021 £35

Spain

- W114 Albarino, Bagoas Ledas, Rias Baixas**
A fresh aromatic wine, with flavours of stone fruit. Excellent with seafood. 13% abv 2022 £32
- W115 Zuri, Rioja Blanco, Luberti**
Crisp acidity with notes of green apple and citrus fruits. Floral on the nose with huge intensity and structure. 13.5% abv 2022 £28

- W400 Domaine Houchart, Cotes de Provence Rosé**
Soft, dry style with lots of ripe summer berries on the nose and a refreshingly zippy palate. 13.5% abv 2021 £33

W203	Fleurie, Vieilles Vignes, Bernard Metrat <i>A classic Beaujolais, brimming with bright red berry notes, this is a forward and easy drinking wine that retains plenty of character and complexity. 13% abv</i>	2018	£40
W204	Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Beaune <i>A crisp and crunchy Pinot Noir. A fine nose, open and very concentrated in red fruits (often raspberry). The palate is soft, well-rounded and fresh. 12.5% abv</i>	2019	£46
W205	Chateau Cissac Cru Bourgeois Haut-Medoc <i>Deep dark colour, elegant depth, fine balance of oak. 14% abv</i>	2018	£52
W206	Château Saintayme, Saint Émilion Grand Cru <i>Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon The palate possesses lots of depth, refreshing acidity and crunchy, red and black fruit, mineral touches and refined tannins. 13% abv</i>	2020	£50
W207	Santenay, Bachelet Monnot, Burgundy <i>Classic Burgundy Pinot Noir. Bouquet of rose petals, red berries, with a hint of liquorice. 13% abv</i>	2016	£70
W208	Gigondas, Cuvée de la Tour Sarrazine, Domaine Le Clos des Cazaux <i>Intense dark colour with notes of black cherry and cocoa nib, slight kick of cinnamon spice. 14.5% abv</i>	2020	£50
W209	Chateau Tayac, Bordeaux Margaux <i>Showing fragrant notes of dark cherries and blackberry, with beautiful length of leather and earth. With great structure and smooth balance. 13.5% abv</i>	2015	£66



Italy

- W210 **Nero D'Avola, Poggio Anima** 2021 £26
From Sicily, with ruby red colours and warm rounded flavours of blackberries and other dark red fruits. 13% abv
- W211 **Valpolicella Classico, Viviani** 2020 £33
Medium finish. Packed full of strawberry, pomegranate and red cherry, this wine is light and fresh. Simple but charming. 13% abv
- W212 **Barbera d'Alba, Paolo Scavino** 2021 £41
A bold barbera with cherry and prune on the nose. Spicy tastes of red berries on the palate. Plenty of complexity with a dry, plummy finish. 14.5% abv

Spain

- W213 **Priorat, Mas Martinet, Menut** 2020 £44
Nicely packed with fruit, defined aroma of plum, blueberry, tobacco and wild spice. These flavours explode on the palate and the finish is quite refined. 15% abv
- W214 **Raúl Pérez Ultreia, Saint Jacques** 2020 £37
Vibrant and fresh, with juicy blueberry and cranberry, with fresh mint and hints of forest fruit leading into a savoury saline finish 13.5% abv
- W215 **Rioja, Artuke, Tempranillo** 2021 £29
Dry, very well balanced, with summer berry fruit, vanilla aromas and chocolate undertones. Very fine tannins and good acidity. 13.5% abv

Nesso, Cantina Goccia, Umbria, Sangiovese

Pronounced notes of cherry and red plum excite the palate with hints of liquorice. A pleasantly dry Umbrian sangiovese. 14.5% abv





South Africa

W216 **Patatsfontein, Chenin Blanc** 2021 £33
With notes of pear and peach on the nose. Bursting with energy, this wine offers a refreshing yet equally delicate value. 12.5 % abv

New Zealand

W217 **Palliser Estate, Martinborough, Sauvignon Blanc** 2022 £34
100% estate grown Sauvignon Blanc. Aromatically rich with succulent fruit characters such as stone fruit and elderflower. 12.5% abv

Australia

W218 **Eden Valley, Mountadam, Shiraz** 2018 £35
Bold dark berries with a back round of vanilla and black pepper. Full-bodied and velvety compliments this wines dark plum colour. 14.5% abv

Argentina

W219 **Familia Cassone, Malbec** 2021 £27
Intense flavours of berries and subtle hints of spice. Colours that express joy with dark violet and red. Soft, ripe Tannins with a long lasting finish. 14% abv
